It is an objective of OGCancerNI to raise awareness of the profile of OG cancer and this is why the OG van is out and about around the province. Another barrier to the detection of this disease is the lack of a screening process. We are so pleased that, under the direction of Dr Mainie, plans are in place to bring a Cytosponge screening test to more people. There are other pleasing advances in the detection and treatment of OG cancer in the past few years. However, more needs to be done to improve the survival rate for these cancers. The OG cancer charity is busy catching up after the Covid pandemic. We held a very successful Well-being meeting in the Lisburn Civic Centre on 1st April,

and plans are already well under way for our next meeting in the Great Hall at Queen's University on 30th September 2023 plus a meeting at the Foyle Centre in the North West on 11th November 2023. We are also excited that our Information Stand in the Belfast City Hospital will start again in September 2023. The timing of the stall coincides with the Outpatients Clinic on a Tuesday morning. We need more volunteers to man the stall on these mornings, for which training will be given.
